Vision and Mission

Our Vision

Madhabdev University is committed towards building a strong nation by bringing in holistic development of the students.

Our Mission

The mission of this University is to empower society to overcome backwardness by achieving enlightenment through quality education and to instil the values and philosophy of Mahapurush Sri Sri Madhabdev in the hearts of the people.

New Education Policy 2020 and Its Implementation

By the NEP 2020 guidelines, the UGC published a new Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes on 7th December 2022, incorporating a flexible CBCS, multidisciplinary approach with multiple entry and exit options to help the students pursue their career paths.

In NEP 2020, students who opt to exit after completion of the first year and have secured 40 credits will be awarded a UG certificate if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation., and after completion of the second year and have secured 80 credits will be awarded the UG diploma if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven years. Students who wish to undergo a 3-year UG programme will be awarded a UG Degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing 120 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirement. A four-year UG Honors degree in the major discipline will be awarded to those who complete a four-year degree programme with 160 credits and have satisfied the credit requirements. Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research project or dissertation under the guidance of a faculty member of the University/College. The research project/dissertation will be in the major discipline. The students, who secure 160 credits, including 12 credits from a research project/dissertation, are awarded a UG

Degree (Honours with Research). Students may be permitted to take a break from their studies, but the total duration for completing the programme shall not exceed 7 years.

Madhabdev University offers a Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) leading to the award of BA/BSc Major/ Honours and Honours with Research:

Programmes Offered

FOUR-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME

Assamese, Botany, Chemistry, Economics, Education, English, History, Mathematics, Philosophy, Political Science, Physics, Sociology and Zoology

Admission Criteria

The Admission for FYUGP will be through the Assam Higher Education Integrated Portal **Common Admission Portal (e-SAMARTH)**, Govt of Assam. The minimum eligibility for admission into the following Programmes shall be as follows:

- a) **Bachelor of Arts (BA):** 10+2 or equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate for General Category and 45% or equivalent grade in aggregate for SC/ST/OBC (**non-creamy layer**)/ PWD from any recognized board or any other examination considered equivalent by the University.
- b) **Bachelor of Science (BSc):** 10+2 or equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate for General Category and 45% or equivalent grade in aggregate for SC/ST/OBC (**non-creamy layer**)/ PWD from any recognized board or any other examination considered equivalent by the University.

Admission Procedure

Admission to various Undergraduate Programmes at Madhabdev University will be conducted online through the Assam State Higher Education Admission portal (SAMARTH). The University has participated in CUET UG 2026 with a 10% reservation of seats for in-campus candidates, and admissions for the remaining 90% will be based on merit through the SAMARTH portal. **A preference-based merit list will be prepared on the basis of the total marks obtained in the best five subjects in the HS examination, including Core subjects.** Admissions to all semesters will be through the online mode. Applications for admission to different programmes will be published in the University website as per the Govt. of Assam common schedule. The minimum eligibility for admission into the following Programmes shall be as follows:

The admission or eligibility criteria shall be fixed by the Academic Council from time to time whenever necessary. The University may adopt its policy for admission or selection of eligible candidates for admission. No student shall be eligible for admission to an academic programme in any discipline unless he/she has completed

the qualifying examination fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria from a University/Institution recognized by Madhabdev University.

Programme Structure

The Programme structure of the academic programme under the CBCS shall be as per the course structure given in Annexure I. The nature of the courses for all undergraduate academic programmes shall be as follows-

a) Major Courses: Compulsory component of an academic programme, these courses are to be studied as a core requirement for the programme. The course contents of the core courses shall be as per the UGC model curriculum for the subject of the discipline concerned.

b) Minor Courses: Students will have the option to choose courses from disciplinary/interdisciplinary minors and skill-based courses relating to a chosen vocational education programme. Students who take a sufficient number of courses in a discipline or an interdisciplinary area of study other than the chosen major will qualify for a minor in that discipline or the chosen interdisciplinary area of study. A student may declare the choice of the minor and vocational stream at the end of the second semester, after exploring various courses. These courses shall be:

- i) Supportive of the discipline of study
- ii) Providing an expanded scope
- iii) Enabling an exposure to some other discipline/domain
- iv) Nurturing student proficiency/skill

c) Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC): All UG students are required to undergo introductory-level courses relating to any of the broad disciplines. These courses are intended to broaden the intellectual expertise and form part of liberal arts and science education. Students are not allowed to choose or repeat courses already undergone at the higher secondary level (12th class) in the proposed major and minor stream under this category.

d) Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC):

The Ability Enhancement Course shall be interdisciplinary in nature. AEC Courses are based on the content that leads to knowledge enhancement.

e) Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC):

These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge, continuing both theory and lab/hands-on/training/fieldwork. The main purpose of these courses is to provide students with life skills in a hands-on mode to increase their employability.

f) Value Added Courses (VAC):

These activities help in character building, spiritual growth, physical growth, etc. They facilitate the development of various domains of mind and personality, such as intellectual, emotional, social, moral and aesthetic developments. These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based Education.

A Course in the form of a Dissertation/Project work/ Practical/ Field work/ Seminar, etc. in different Semesters along with Internship/ Community Engagement course. A student shall have to study the academic programme as per the scheme of the

programme. Even if a candidate earns the required number of credits before completion of the full duration of the programme, he/she shall not be entitled to the degree.

Pass Percentage

To pass an undergraduate (UG) programme, a student must achieve an overall score of at least 40% per course, including both internal assessment and theory components. Additionally, a minimum of 30% must be secured in the theory component alone to qualify.

Reservation of Seats

(I) Statutory Reservation:

In all academic programmes, there are provisions for the reservation of seats as defined by statutory provision. The Statutory Reservations in each category are given below:

Scheduled Caste (SC)	7%
Scheduled Tribes, Plains (ST-P)	10%
Scheduled Tribes, Hills (ST-H)	5%
Other Backwards Classes (OBC/MOBC) (Non-creamy layer)	27%
Economically Backwards Sections (EWS)	10%

(II) Reservation of Specially-abled Persons: 5% of the total seats in all the Academic Programmes are reserved for differently-abled students/persons with benchmark disabilities.

(III) Sons and Daughters of Madhabdev University Employees: One seat in each department of Madhabdev University is reserved for sons and daughters of the employees of Madhabdev University working in the regular posts, subject to the fulfilment of eligibility criteria.

(IV) Extra-Curricular Activities: 5% of the total seats across all the Academic Programmes

(1) Sports:

Eligibility:

- (i) Must have represented in any of the Olympic disciplines or Cricket conducted by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi/National Sports Federation as recognized by the Sports Authority of India (SAI)/Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.
- (ii) Participation in the above-mentioned games and sports must not be earlier than three years before the academic session in which admission is sought.
- (iii) The candidates may have to appear in a Qualifying Test in the concerned sports.

(2) Art/Culture/ Literary/ NCSC:

Eligibility:

- (i) Proficiency in Fine Arts/ Performing Arts, as evidenced by participation at the recognized Regional/National level competitions.
- (ii) Certificate of winning awards/prizes in literary competitions at the Inter-University/National level **or** having a standard published work. (Selection will be made by a committee to be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.)

(iii) The candidates may have to appear in a Qualifying Test in the concerned activity of art/culture/literacy.

(iv) Certificate of participation at the National Level of National Children's Science Congress (NCSC) or Bigyan Anusandhan.

(3) NCC:

Eligibility:

Representation of the State (of Assam) in the Republic Day Parade in New Delhi sponsored by the Regional Directorate, NCC or having an NCC 'C' Certificate.

(4) NSS:

Eligibility:

Candidates applying under the NSS Quota for admission into the various under Graduate Academic Programmes offered at Madhabdev University must have an NSS completion certificate issued by the NSS Cell/Unit last attended. The applicant must possess the minimum qualifying marks in his/her HS final examination as per the rules of the University. However, the candidates having the minimum qualifying criteria (NSS Completion Certificate and minimum Qualification marks) will be selected based on possession of the certificates placed below in order of weightage:

- a. National Level NSS Awardees
- b. State Level NSS Awardees
- c. Member of the Indian Youth Delegation Team (International Youth Exchange)
- d. Republic Day Camp Participants
- e. Participation in various National Level NSS Camps and Programmes
- f. Participation in various State Level NSS Camps
- g. In case of equal weightage between two candidates, the final selection will be based on marks obtained in the TDC final examinations.

(5) Rover and Ranger

Candidates applying under Rover and Ranger Quota for admission into the various under Graduate Academic Programmes offered at Madhabdev University must have a Rover and Ranger completion certificate issued by the Rover and Ranger Unit last attended.

(6) Tea and Ex-Tea garden Community:

Eligibility

Must be a permanent resident of Assam.

Ordinances of Discipline

- i. Every student should always carry in person his/her Identity Card issued by the University. The loss of the Identity Card, whenever it occurs, should immediately be reported in writing to the Dean of Students' Welfare.

- ii. Any violation of the code of conduct or breach of any rules or regulations of the University by any student shall constitute an act of indiscipline and should make him/her liable for disciplinary action.
- iii. The Dean of Students' Welfare will deal with the welfare and discipline of all students on the campus, including the Hostel and also outside the campus and will ensure the maintenance of good conduct.
- iv. No student will use unfair means in any of the examinations and tests or attempt or threaten the staff to get an undue advantage. Disciplinary action will be taken against defaulters as per the rules of the University.
- v. Students must pay all fees and other dues by the specified dates. If they do not do so, they render themselves liable to penalties as in force from time to time.
- vi. Students must take good care of all University properties. Any damage to University property shall be viewed as indiscipline. Such students, in addition to facing disciplinary action, shall have to replace the damaged property and make good the losses caused by their actions. Students must use the furniture and fittings with due care and must not deface buildings, roads, furniture and fittings, etc. in any manner.
- vii. Ragging in any form is unlawful and prohibited. Students found involved in ragging shall be expelled from the University, and FIRs shall be lodged against them as per orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- viii. Smoking, spitting, consumption/ possession of liquor, intoxicants, drugs, tobacco products, etc. on the campus are strictly prohibited. Any violation may invoke a severe penalty.

Anti-Ragging Measures

The University adopts a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging and has strict guidelines on the same as per policies of the UGC in vogue and compliance with directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

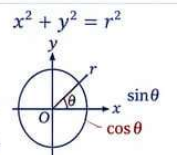

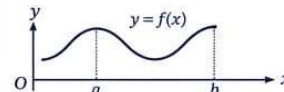
