About the University

The birth place of several Baishnava Gurus like Madhabdev, Haridev, Aniruddhadev, Badala Padma Atta, Narayanpur is an important historical place in the western part of Lakhimpur district of Assam. Founded in 1964, Madhabdev College in Narayanpur is one of the leading centres of higher education in Lakhimpur district with both humanities and science. The state government of Assam has upgraded the Madhabdev College to Madhabdev University in 2019 under the Assam Act No. XXXV of 2017.

Department of Botany, Madhabdev University & NSS Madhabdev University Unit in Collaboration with Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development, Sriperumbudur, Tamil Nadu is organizing an Off-line three days National workshop on *“Disaster Management with reference to Floods and Landslides of Assam”* for NSS Volunteers, UG & PG students and Research Scholars of Assam during 04-06 August, 2022. The program is sponsored by Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development, Sriperumbudur (RGNIYD).

Need & Importance of the Programme:

Natural hazards and disasters like floods, landslides are unforeseen event that becomes suddenly overwhelming and destructive, deadly and disruptive. Floods and landslides are two major natural disasters of Assam. Out of 35 districts, almost 30 districts of the state have been very

badly affected every year by floods and landslide. To formulate a good disaster or flood warrior and for the sake of hazard and disaster management, youth should be the prime focus. There have been several advantages of promoting youth for developmental activities including contribution to nation-building, proper mitigation, and management planning of natural hazards and disasters and that will be fulfilled by imparting proper knowledge and management training to youth. Organizing the proposed workshop we would try to educate and train the youths of flood affected areas and plan effective strategies for reducing disaster risk in their respective localities.

Major areas to be covered in the Programme:

1. Basic concept of Natural Disaster and Hazard.
2. Floods and landslide in Assam and its mitigation in local context.
3. Challenges of women and children during floods.
4. Training Needs Assessment for Flood Risk Reduction.
5. Landslide Hazard Zonation and Mitigation Plan for Upper Assam.
6. Community Based Disaster Risk Reduction and Management.
7. Different flood vulnerability profile of each district of Assam.
8. Systematic approach to Disaster Management with reference to Floods and Landslides of Assam.
9. Mock drills will be conducted amongst the participants to deal with various disaster situations like floods, landslides, earthquake, fire etc.
10. Field Visit to some flood and landslide affected villages of Lakhimpur and Dhemaji district of Assam.

Mode of Conduct:

The program will be conducted in physical mode at Madhabdev University, Narayanpur. Out of three days, one day will be Field Visit to some flood and landslide affected villages of Lakhimpur and Dhemaji district of Assam. Selected participants will have to attend all the sessions.

Who can apply: NSS Volunteers, UG & PG students and Research Scholars. Applicants must submit valid ID proof on the first day of the workshop.

Number of Participants: Total number of seats is 50. The students belonging to SC/ST and NSS Volunteers of nearby colleges may be included to the maximum extent possible.
