The University is implementing the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) from the Academic Session 2022-23

Selection of Subject and Intake Capacity

- A student has to select two subjects as Core I and Core II and one Open Elective subject other than the Core subjects offered by a department.
- The student must not choose two Language subjects (e.g. Assamese & English) as Core-I, Core-II or Open Elective Course (OEC).
- Apart from the above mentioned subjects, a student has to study one Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC), one Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and one Value Based Course (VBC) like NCC, NSS, Yoga, Sports, Culture, Rover and Ranger which will be allotted to the students in due time.
- Intake capacity for all departments except statistics will be 40. In case of Statistics, the intake capacity will be 20 only.

Admission Criteria

The eligibility for admission into the BA/BSc Programmes shall be as follows:

a) Bachelor of Arts (BA): The applicants should have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, Central Board of Secondary Education or an equivalent examination (10+2) recognized as such by the University.

b) Bachelor of Science (BSc): A student should have passed the Higher Secondary Examinations (10+2) in Science Stream of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, Central Board of Secondary Education or an equivalent examination (10+2) recognized as such by the University. For admission into BSc in Chemistry and Physics Core, a candidate must pass the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Science stream of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, Central Board of Secondary Education or an equivalent examination with Mathematics as a subject.

How to apply: The candidates must apply online by furnishing the details of their candidature along with the bank details- Bank name, Branch name, IFSC, Account Number of self or parents, Mobile numbers and email id. Once the data is submitted the same cannot be changed during their tenure in the University, else they will be deprived from the Government beneficiary schemes. The candidate must furnish domicile certificate like- PRC/Voter Identity Card of self or parents/NRC of self or parents/ AADHAAR card of self or parents/ BPL Card of family/ Birth certificate issued by Registrar of Birth and Death/ passport of self or parents. The Candidate must give an undertaking in this regard.

The candidates have to upload the following documents in the online portal for admission:

1. H.S.L.C. Mark sheet and Certificate (below 200 kb)
2. H.S. Mark sheet and Certificate (below 200 kb)
3. Domicile Certificate (below 200 kb)
4. Caste Certificate of Self/ Parents (below 200 kb)
5. Recent Passport Size Colour Photo (below 100 kb)

Reservation of seats: Seats are reserved as per the government reservation policy- EWS-10%, ST(P)- 10%, ST(H)-5%, SC-7%, OBC/MOBC-27%

Free Admission Scheme

The Government of Assam has introduced free admission scheme to the students. The University is also implementing the scheme.

Applicability and Category of students eligible under the scheme:

Students whose parental annual income is less than Rs.2.00 lakh from all sources will be eligible to avail this scheme. If either of the parents (mother or father) of the student is working in the State Govt./ Central Govt./Semi Govt./State or Central Govt. undertakings sectors, such students shall not be eligible under this scheme

The University will realize only Magazine fee, Games & Sports fee, and Varsity Week Fee. All other fee will be exempted.

Proof of Income/Documents required:

- (i) An Income Certificate from the concerned Revenue Circle Officer only
- (ii) A declaration from the student that neither of the parents (father or mother) of the student is an employee of State/Central Govt. Department or its undertaking. If such a declaration is found to be false, the admission shall be cancelled and fee shall be realized from such students.

Duties and Responsibilities of Students availing the Scheme:

Students seeking admission into 1st year will plant a sapling at his /her home and shall give photograph of the same to the University. The student has to nurse the sapling and while seeking admission into second year, he/she will give photograph of the same tree that was planted during previous year. A Scrutiny Committee shall be constituted comprising of teachers which will examine the photographs and assess the genuineness of the Photographs and growth of the plant. Student can avail subsequent year fee waive only on receipt of the recommendation from the Committee.

Course Structure

The course structure of the academic programme under the NEP 2020 shall be as per the course structure given below. The nature of the courses for all undergraduate academic programmes shall be as follows-

a) Core Courses: Compulsory component of an academic programme.

b) Open Elective (OE)/ Generic Elective Courses (GE): Elective Courses shall be chosen by each student from a pool of courses. These courses may be intra-departmental, i.e., Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) as well as inter-departmental, i.e., Open Elective (OE)/ Generic Elective (GE).

c) Ability Enhancement Course (AEC): The Ability Enhancement Courses shall be inter-disciplinary in nature. AEC Courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to knowledge enhancement. This course has two components-

1. Part-A: Communicative English
Part-B: Assamese Communication/Alternative English

2. Part-A: Environmental Studies

Part-B: Madhabdev Studies

d) Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge comprising both theory and lab/hands-on/training/fieldwork.

e) Value Based Courses (VBC): Courses may also take the form of a pool of value added courses like NCC/NSS/Sport/Yoga/ Culture/ Rover and Ranger etc.

Courses may also take the form of Dissertation/Project work/ Practical/ Field work/ Seminar, etc. in final Semester. A student shall have to study the academic programme as per the scheme of the programme.
